5.4 REGIONAL COUNCIL UPDATE

Councillor Nicole Marshall highlighted what’s happening at the Regional Council:

- The Zone Committee Review is proceeding and scheduled to be completed by August. A review will also be completed on the Regional Committee to see if it is still fit for purpose
- Clarification has been requested on conflicts of interest management
- The CE recruitment is underway, with hopes to have appointment in August
- The Annual Plan is being signed off tomorrow (18 June), with an average rate increase of 4%
- A Coastal Plan review is scheduled
- The hearings for submissions on Oceania Dairy Ltd’s ocean pipeline & discharge consents is possibly the end of July – all submissions are now available online
- Applications were declined for Ngai Tahu representation on ECan. There are difficulties within the different acts (LGA and ECan Act). A meeting will be held with the iwi representatives to progress this)
- The Government’s Essential Freshwater Package has been released and when passed into law will have implications on current plans and new targets will need to be set

5.5 INZ BUILDING TRUST UPDATE - JUNE 2020

Irrigation NZ Chief Executive Elizabeth Soal, and Craig Evans, Chief Executive of Morven Glenavy Ikawai Irrigation presented a powerpoint and answered questions. 'Building Trust' is a national project being piloted in the Waitaki catchment managed by Irrigation NZ. The project has created a portal for combining water quality data from sources such as regional council and irrigation schemes to provide communities with transparent information about water quality, trends and actions being undertaken to address water quality issues. The proposed launch date is July.

THIS IS AN UPDATE FOR EVERYONE THAT WE MET AT GERT VANTKLOOSTERS PLACE LAST FRIDAY TO LOOK AT THE RIVER EROSION ISSUE THAT HAS ARISEN ON HIS PROPERTY AND ALSO ON OTHER SITES ADJACENT TO THE RIVER.I KNOW IT WAS SHORT NOTICE AND THAT MEANT SOME COMMITTEE MEMBERS WERE UNAVAILABLE BUT THANK YOU TO THOSE AND THE ECAN STAFF THAT DID ATTEND.WE ALSO HAD CR SHEILA PAUL AND WAIMATE DEPUTY MAYOR SHARYN CAIN ATTEND THIS MEETING.GERT OUTLINED THE SCALE OF LAND HE HAD LOST AND SHOWED US WHERE HE HAD JUST RECENTLY SPENT 60K WITH A DOZER JUST TO DIVERT ONE OF THE MAIN STREAMS OF THE RIVER AWAY FROM HIS PROPERTY.

I THINK ALL PEOPLE ATTENDING WERE SURPRISED BY THE SCALE OF THE WORKS THAT PRIVATE LAND OWNERS WERE HAVING TO UNDERTAKE TO PROTECT THEIR LAND.

TWO KEY POINTS COMING OUT OF THE MEETING WERE POINT 1 HOW TO SLOW THE LOSS OF LAND AND INFRASTRUCTURE THROUGH EROSION AND HOW IT IS FUNDED IN THE SHORT TIME AND POINT 2 THE NEED FOR A RATING REVIEW TO LOOK AT HOW RATES ARE USED TO MAINTAIN THE RIVER

AFTER THE MEETING HELD IN KUROW FOR ADJACENT LAND OWNERS A RIVER LIAISON GROUP DANIEL ISBISTER FROM OUR COMMITTEE IS A MEMBER. THEY WISH TO LOOK AT HOW TO DEAL WITH THE TWO POINTS STATED ABOVE AND TO FORM A VIEW OF HOW ECAN ARE MONITORING THE MERIDIAN CONSENT

OF PARTICULAR INTEREST TO THIS GROUP ARE

CONDITION 1 WHICH STATES THE GRANTEE(MERIDIAN) SHALL EXERCISE THIS PERMIT IN CONJUNCTION WITH ALL OTHER RIGHTS WHICH THE GRANTEE HOLDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE GENERATION OF ELECTRICITY WITH IN THE WAITAKI RIVER SYSTEM, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO MINIMISE, AS FAR AS POSSIBLE, ANY ADVERSE EFFECTS OF THE RIGHTS ON THE WAITAKI RIVER SYSTEM

CONDITION 7 WHICH STATES THE GRANTEE(MERIDIAN) SHALL: A)TAKE SUCH PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES WHICH THE CANTERBURY REGIONAL COUNCIL MAY REQUIRE TO PREVENT DAMAGE FROM EROSION WHICH IS LIKELY TO OCCUR AS A RESULT OF THE EXERCISE OF THIS PERMIT : AND, B) MAKE SUCH REMEDIAL REPAIRS WHICH CANTERBURY REGIONAL COUNCIL MAY REQUIRE TO REMEDY DAMAGE FROM EROSION WHICH OCCURS AS A RESULT OF THE EXERCISE OF THIS PERMIT

RIVER LIASON GROUP WILL BE LOOKING FOR A RECOMMENDATION OF SUPPORT FROM US TO ENSURE THESE CONDITIONS OF CONSENT ARE BEING MONITORED CORRECTLY BY ECAN
